

Poster Instructions and Guidelines

In addition to your written paper included in the conference publication, you are required to present your work in the poster session. We will print and put up the poster for you, but you have to submit your poster file in JPEG format on or before 11 July 2008.

The poster session is your opportunity to present your work directly to other delegates and to discuss it with them. It is a useful forum for small group discussion and debate. The display should therefore be visually appealing and should contain the essence of your paper in a form that is easy to understand.

Your display should consist chiefly of keywords, diagrams, photographs, etc. Colour photographs are particularly attractive in a poster display. Diagrams and graphs should have clear captions. All lettering should be easy to read. All graphs and diagrams should be drawn with thick lines (preferably 1mm or more in width). Use colour to emphasize important features.

The poster display is important. You are recommended to take as much trouble with it as you did in preparing your written paper.

You should also clearly display the following information on your poster:

The title of your paper

The authors' names and their affiliations

Your usual contact details (e.g. an email address) to allow delegates to follow up discussion.
